Like a great many of my constituents who live in or near Great Glen and the local county councillor, Dr Kevin Feltham, I too wish to object to the application by the CWS to build a crematorium, a cemetery, a woodland burial ground and a car park on land between the old A6 London Road and the A6 Great Glen by-pass, and to express my support for these constituents and to register with you my concerns about the CWS's application. You will already have received objections based on the site itself and its proximity to two schools and residential properties, the inevitable traffic increase throughout the day and especially during the morning and afternoon school rush hours and the blight effect it will have on local property values. These are not merely formulaic objections but to my constituents concerns of genuine substance with which I agree.

I understand that the Highways Authority will not permit access to the proposed site from the by-pass so the traffic generated by the growing number of funerals every day will cause congestion in the village and possibly endanger the safety of pedestrians, particularly the children attending Leicester Grammar School and Stoneygate School right next to the proposed site. In short this is not a suitable site for a large complex with high volumes of traffic coming in and out of the site every day. I urge the Planning Committee to reject this application.
